Leopalace21's Measures in Response to the Tohoku-Pacific Ocean Earthquake

Leopalace21 has implemented the following measures in response to the earthquake and tsunami that struck the Tohoku region on March 11, 2011.

Leopalace21's Measures

1. Immediately following the disaster Leopalace21 took steps to confirm the safety of owners and residents. At the same time, we dispatched an inspection team comprising 134 licensed architects of the first class to confirm the safety of residences. Vacant units that have been confirmed as safe are being quickly readied for use, mainly for victims of the disaster, as well as for companies and organizations involved with the relief effort.
